The original buildings founded by Father Ray Brennan were recently completely

renovated and updated to include fire escapes, alarm systems, and more. The cost to reconstruct was over 13 Million Baht. The School for Deaf

vocational training schools in the region. There are currently 183 students attending.

Her Royal Highness Crown Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn officially opened the new 3 storey building on 15th February 2007. The security system is designed to international standards being 18 meters wide and 52.5 meters long, containing 2100 square meters, designed for multi-purpose use; dormitory for female students, computer workrooms, language rooms, and a study room. The cost for this building was over 21 Million Baht and an additional

9.7 Million Baht was added for the teaching, educational equipment, etc. Father Larry Patin, Director of the Fr. Ray Foundation, has extended the invitation to everyone to stop by to see the wonderful work they do and said that he believes that all in our community should be aware of how they can help so many disadvantaged people. A visit will be a heart rendering experience for the young and old.

On that day the classrooms were open for all and many people attended the celebration with their families and children.

New P.I.L.C. Map of Pattaya Launch

A standing-room-only crowd of invited guests got their first look at the Pattaya International Ladies Club's new Pattaya map during a champagne Map Launch Party hosted by the Manhattan Steak House on Friday, September 14th. The map, which measures 24 x 43 inches (about 61 x 109 centimeters) when unfolded, is unique in several respects, as explained by PILC President Rosanne Diamente. First, all proceeds from the sale of the map will go to local charities. Second, the map is actually much more than just a tourist map; it is also a reference guide for local residents and expats.

The very detailed map includes not only Pattaya, Jomtien and Naklua, but also Sri Racha, Ban Chang, Rayong, the

Rayong Resort Area, Map Ta Phut, and a general view of the Eastern Seaboard. In addition



to hotels, restaurants, and attractions, the map shows locations of schools, banks, health facilities and pharmacies, government offices, permanent housing, sports facilities, shopping areas and a myriad of other businesses. Best of all, it

includes a listing of every item on the map, grouped by category, complete with grid coordinates, making it easy to

locate anything on the map. "It has everything you need to live here," says PILC member Sylvia Berra, who led the volunteer effort to produce the

map. Sylvia said the idea for the map grew out of the Pattaya and Rayong Guide that PILC has produced for many years. She said she and her team of volunteers started out with the intent of updating the guidebook, but with her

background as a civil engineer she found it was easier to first produce the map. It took about six months of hard work of walking the streets to locate everything, and the task was made more difficult because of the fast pace at which Pattaya is growing and changing.

"It was a team effort," says Sylvia. She especially thanked Khun Tiew of Phuluang for providing the information for the Rayong portions of the map, and Rosanne Diamente and Judy Clausen for finding businesses to sponsor the production of the map.
