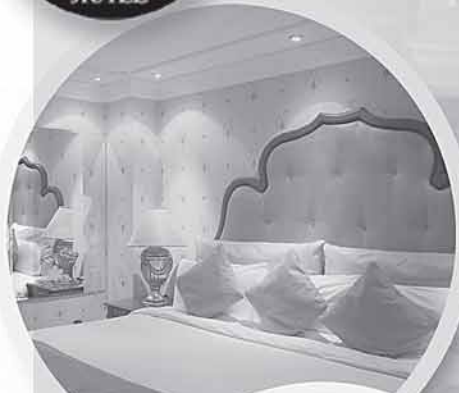
planned to be ready by November. There are daily flights from Bangkok to Manila with Philippines Airways, Kuwait Airways and morning and afternoon flights with Thai Airways. I spoke with several Pattaya residents who flew direct to Clarkbase, the Angeles International Airport where the Airbus 380 can land in the future. The largest airplane in the world cannot land at the Manila airport. If you want to fly direct to Angeles-Clark then you have to make a stop over in Hong Kong for 2 hours or Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia). A great alternative, as I want to do the next time and stay one or two days in Hong Kong and Kuala Lumpur to see some friends from a long time ago. Angeles City is getting more attractive and also the property market is

booming for these reasons. There are also plans in the future to get 2 weekly flights direct from Utapou to Angeles-Clark. This would be a dream for every Pattaya resident as they can save more than 50% of their travel time. But hopefully more news soon about this idea, in association with Pattaya People, ABC Hotel, the Filipino Tourist Department and PATA, Pattaya, Angeles Travel Association. For most tourists it's a great pleasure that the Filipinos are friendly and speak good English, as they learn this in school. Thanks to the Americans who controlled the Philippines for 48 years after the Second World War and gave the Filipinos a good education as the classes in schools are bilingual. For that reason, the Filipino labour force is the
